

CRITERIA FOR A CONTRACTOR TO BE A MEMBER OF IULCA

In order to qualify for active membership in the Association, the applicant must:

- (a) At the time of application for membership and during the whole of its time of membership, have engaged in operating a landscaping business. The applicant shall cease being a member in the Association should they, at any time, not be so engaged;
- (b) Have completed at least one job in the past two years.
- (c) Upon request, submit a list of jobs successfully completed (including the locations and names of the applicable builder and/or clients) within a specified time period;
- (d) Upon request, submit reference letters addressed to the IULCA from either owners and/or general contractors describing the work and attesting to the satisfactory performance of it by the landscaping contractor;
- (e) Agree to be freely bound by the Constitution and By-laws of the Association;
- (f) Complete a formal application and submit it along with the membership fee, in the amount of \$ 200 (plus HST) payable to the Independent Unionized Landscape Contractors Association, and remit annual dues as set by the Directors at the Annual General Meeting;
- (g) Upon receipt of the application for membership to IULCA, the IULCA will place the application on the agenda at the next General Meeting for review;
- (h) Await approval of the application for membership by the Association's members and Board of Directors;
- (i) After membership is approved by the IULCA, a one year probationary period must be served before the full membership is attained.
